#### BIBLE STUDY MEETS FEBRUARY 7

After the holidays and a break to prepare for the Annual Congregational Meeting, the Bible Study group is ready to continue the Book of John. The next meeting date is **Wednesday**, **February 7**, **at 6:35 pm**, **via Zoom**. A link to this online meeting will be sent prior to the gathering.

The group will be working from the study book and will be discussing Lesson 11 (John 19:17-42: Obedient to Death). If you are in need of a study book, please contact Elaine Schmidt. One will be provided for you. To join the group for the first time, please email FPCR or contact Elaine Schmidt.

The last discussion was held in November. The group found the lesson, which covered John 18:28-19:16, to be interesting. They also felt there was a lot to learn. The lesson began by stating that many people were responsible for Jesus' death. Who were they? Does that mean each of us as well? After all, he died for *our* sins! The lesson taught us that no one was responsible—he willingly submitted to death for our sins. What a price he paid for us!

#### SOUP AND SOAP FOR FEBRUARY

In January, your boxes of cereal found immediate space on the bare Pantry shelves. Slinger Food Pantry Liaisons, Rick and Cathy Romanski, packed the donations in the narthex on Monday, January 29, and delivered them to the Pantry. Though the Pantry still has many staples in stock, they were "cleaned out" of kid's cereal, so they very much appreciated seeing the Romanskis at the door on January 29.

#### **BEGINNING OF FEBRUARY**



Though February 11 marks the 58th (LVIII) Super Bowl, that is not true at FPCR. The FPCR family will mark Super Bowl Sunday by holding the FIRST Soup-er Bowl! Bring one or more cans of soup for the Pantry between now and February 11. All brands, kinds, and sizes will be gratefully accepted. Soup is another item of great need for the Food Pantry. Therefore, they will be thrilled to see the Romanskis when they

deliver your soup the week after the Super Bowl.

#### SECOND HALF OF FEBRUARY

Another greatly needed category of need for the Pantry is hygiene products. Therefore, from February 12 through 29, FPCR will collect liquid hand soap, body wash, shampoo, conditioner, toothpaste, toothbrushes, mouthwash, etc. You are probably able to think of some other necessary hygiene products. ### THE 2023 ANNUAL MEETING IS A WRAP!

FPCR's 2023 Annual Congregational Meeting was held Sunday, January 28, 2024, following the service. Attendees moved to the Fellowship Hall for a lunch of sub sandwiches and the meeting.

Pastor Cathy Manthei moderated the meeting:

- A quorum was declared.
- Reports and motions made and accepted included:
  - Last year's meeting minutes
  - Statistical report (32 members at the end of 2023.)
  - Benevolence (\$6,546.00. Of this amount, \$2,437 plus \$110 from Peace/ Global Witness Offering was paid to the Slinger Food Pantry.)
  - Nominating Committee (Two elders nominated for the Class of 2027:
     Jackson Kujawa and Ken Schmidt; one deacon for the Class of 2027, Rick
     Romanski; seven members to the nominating committee: Melissa Kujawa,
     Chairwoman; Elaine Schmidt; Allen Schoeni; Elaine Schoeni; Jean Schoeni;
     and Jean Zeller. Carol Frank and Jim Frank are the two alternates.)
  - Deacon's report (FPCR's average attendance was 22.)
  - Audit report (No exceptions found.)
  - Treasurer's report (Net income for 2023 = \$5,257.23.)
  - Approved budget was distributed.
- The building fix-it list was reviewed. The session plus other interested parties will attempt a walk-through of the building and property this spring. It was postponed last fall.
- Pastor Cathy explained a few intricacies of her "calling" to FPCR (copies of her contract were included in the meeting packet).
- The by-laws change was discussed and tabled for next year's meeting. The discussion is whether to move from five to three elders.
- Flock Notes (an online communication tool) should be received by you on Sunday
  or Monday of each week. It will become the main method of communication for
  the prayer chain, church happenings, summaries of services, etc. Contact Pastor
  Cathy if you have questions or are not (but would like to) receive Flock Notes.
- The FPCR Directory will be updated over the next several weeks and then distributed.
- Elaine Schmidt accepted her position as Clerk of Session; Alice Schmitz, Treasurer.
- A motion was made to read/review these minutes and approve them at next year's meeting.
- The meeting was adjourned with a prayer.
